



## March Gardening Tips

### Prune:

- ❖ all fruit trees before growth begins
- ❖ tea, floribunda & grandiflora roses but WAIT on climbers and ramblers until after flowering
- ❖ leggy perennials
- ❖ WAIT to prune evergreens, hedges & shrubs until late spring/early summer.

### Fertilize:

- deciduous broad-leaved & needle evergreen trees & shrubs (if not fed in the fall)
- roses when new growth begins
- and lime vegetable garden

### Plant:

- roses
- divide & transplant summer blooming perennials
- spinach, peas, broccoli, as soon as soil is workable
- direct sow radish & lettuce

### Also:

- remove winter mulch from planting beds
- remove protective cover from evergreens
- reset frost-heaved plants
- add compost to garden or planting beds
